Community Festival Days

Who: Everyone, kids, adults, families, community groups

Where: ERBG in the new Children's playground.

What: The FREE family friendly all ages festival days will include opportunities to be guided in mud squishing, mixing, passing, dancing, impromptu musical performances, mud chants, wild rhythmical clapping and great family entertainment.

How: The raw materials get mixed by rhythmical stomping, mixing and team work, after being placed in forms and sun dried the bricks will be used to build walls, tunnels, arches, furniture and rendered to complete the mud cubby.

When: Festival days run from 10am–2pm with food and drinks available onsite

What to Bring: Clothes suitable for muddy fun, your voice, chairs, shade a picnic if you wish, hats, and your own musical instrument to join the music fun arranged and conducted by Kim Edgar-Lane and Damon Lane.
